PROGRAM CRITERIA

SynoVation Valley Leadership Academy is an integrative program that will provide innovative knowledge and skill-building resources. All good things do require commitment and effort; participants are expected to:

- Participate in odyssey groups and reading activities between sessions
- Produce a strategic personal leadership action plan

Valley County registrants will receive first priority to participate in *SVLA*. Valley County registrants are considered to be individuals who live and/or work in Valley County. Registrants who do not live or work in Valley County will be considered after all registrations from Valley County individuals are reviewed. The maximum class size is 30 participants.
