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SynoVation Valley Leadership Academy Tuition Assistance Program

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Valley County Community Foundation Fund (VCCFF) Advisory Committee recognizes the importance of growing leadership capacity to ensure community vitality. We value every person's innate abilities to serve as a leader within his or her families, workplace and community. The VCCFF invests in people through supporting dynamic programming and opportunities that foster individual growth and community engagement.

The Valley County Community Foundation Fund is a strong supporter of the SynoVation Valley Leadership Academy with annual grants from endowment funds. This year, thanks to expanded support from the Valley County Community Foundation Fund, SVLA will be offering tuition assistance of \$200 for five Level 1 participants.

The pricing structure and registration deadlines for the 2018-2019 Academy are listed below. This tuition rate does not include the \$200 scholarship. If an applicant has already registered for the academy during the early bird period, the early bird tuition rate will be honored.

INVESTMENT: for applicants living and/or working in Valley County:

Registration: \$1,600 → \$600 (register after April 27, 2018)

INVESTMENT: for applicants not living or working in Valley County:

Registration: \$2,000 → \$700

The final deadline for SVLA registration is May 31, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.

WHO CAN RECEIVE A SCHOLARSHIP?

People who live in Valley County and are registering for the SVLA-Level 1 Academy are invited to submit a scholarship application. Community members are eligible for the SVLA scholarship whether they are paying for the tuition personally or tuition is being paid for by their business, employer, or organization.

WHEN IS THE SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE?

The application deadline for the SVLA scholarship is **Thursday, May 31, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.**

The SVLA selection committee, consisting of four advanced level SVLA participants, will review applications the following week. Scholarship recipients will be notified by June 11, 2018 at noon.

Scholarships will be awarded by applying a \$200 credit to recipients' SVLA-Level 1 tuition fees.
